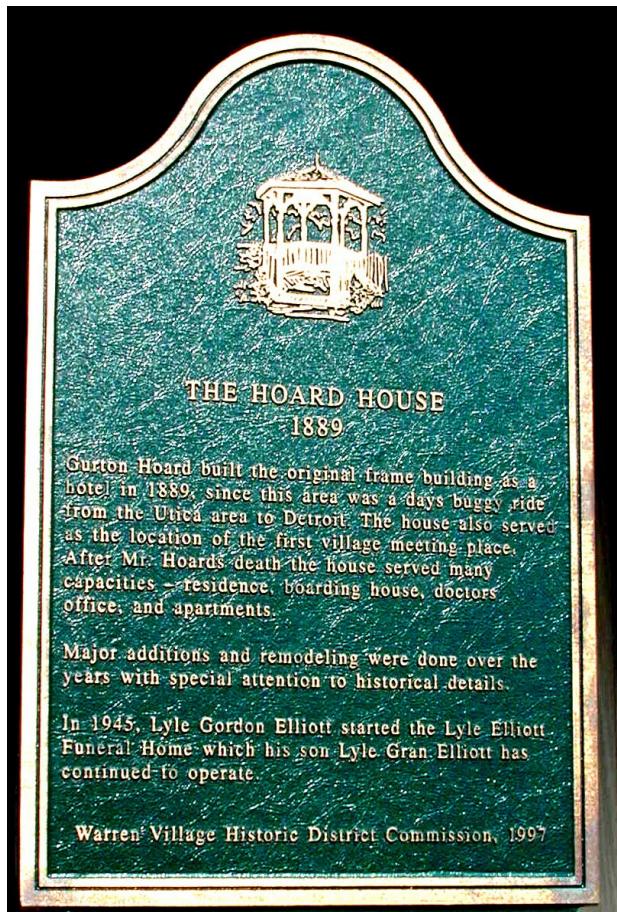
Over time there were several Baptist groups. The humble historian notes that they did not keep historic records.

This Historic marker was donated by families probably touched by Pearl Harbor or 9=11. It was a Memorial to All Veterans and reminded youth to be Vigilant and Be Prepared. Our youth no longer learn much history in school.



The above stone was stolen by two men backed by the Warren Hysterical grave robbing society a social clique. This was not done by the Historical Society as no vote of the membership was taken. There was also no vote to remove this and seven other markers by the Village Commission. See the story at the beginning of this book for details.

Us veterans who put our lives on the line feel that this action was an act of treason and at least extremely disrespectful to those who died in these attacks and to our veterans. This stone honored all veterans unlike the newer one which honors only those buried here. What about our boys who died in other countries and who are not buried here and have no marker elsewhere. Don't they at least deserve a stone honoring them.

This stone was not hurting anything. They nave no right to steal property placed by families and which they do not own from a cemetery they do not own.
