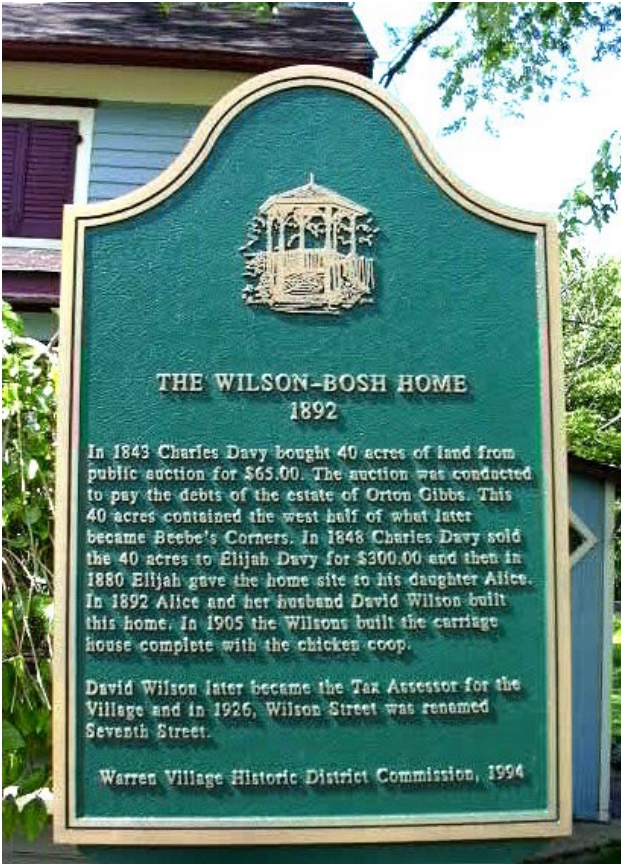


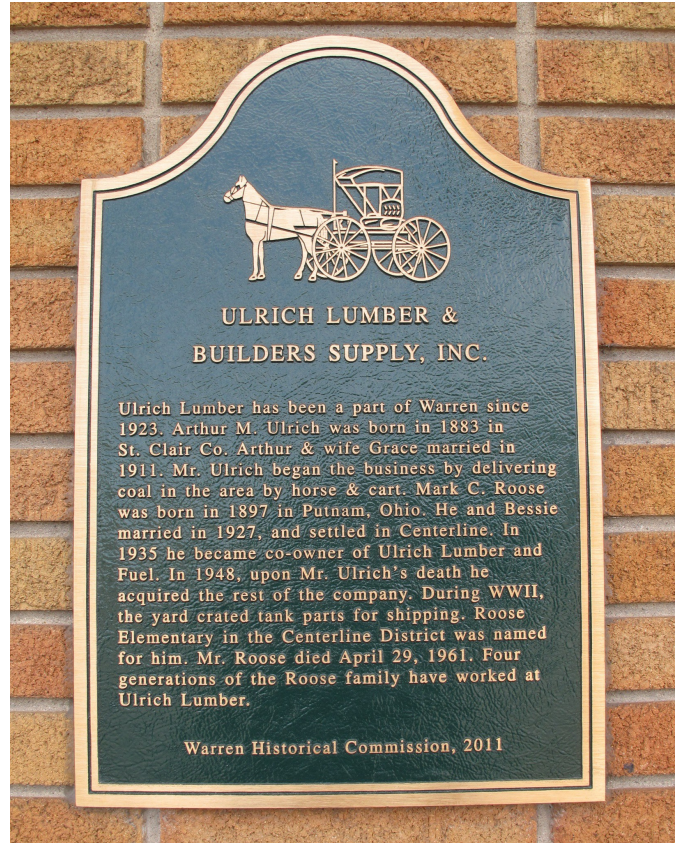
There are several things wrong with this marker. The facts are wrong. There are a lot more than 325 graves from the nineteenth century.
